

Guidelines for Reproducing QST Materials

National Institutes for Quantum Science and Technology (QST)

1. Before Submitting Your Form

- Purpose of Use – Describe the intended use, including any commercial use.
- Details of the QST Copyrighted Works – Identify the publication title and page number, or the webpage title and URL.
- Titles and Details of Use – Provide the eligible recipients, publication/media outlet, and number of copies if applicable.
- Period of Use – If the period of use is not yet fixed, please specify the expected period of use.

2. Reproduction Requirements

- Please indicate the source of the material and whether it has been reproduced as-is or adapted from the original.

Use Type	Example Attribution
Text / Figures	Partially excerpted from a brochure published by the National Institutes for Quantum Science and Technology (QST) (issued on April 1, 2026), p. 11.
Images	Reproduced from the QST website (https://www.qst.go.jp/site/photograph/), accessed on July 1, 2026.
Adapted Material	Adapted from QST NEWS LETTER No.36.

- Proof Copy – Submit a PDF proof, draft, or galley copy together with your application.

3. Terms and Conditions

- The material will be used only for the purpose stated in the application.
- The use of the material will not harm the interests or reputation of QST.
- QST assumes no responsibility for any loss or damage arising from the use of the material.
- One copy of the final publication must be provided to QST. For online publications, please provide the URL of the publication.
- A new application is required for reprints, republication, or other reuse beyond the approved purpose.
